I am writing this letter to you on the last day of 2019, thankful for all that God has done this year! Thank YOU! Because of your "yes" to Jesus and your teamwork in the local church this year, the love of Christ transformed lives locally and in some of the darkest places in the world!

As we turn the corner and think about a fresh start in 2020, as your pastor I want to encourage you to lean in and hear what the Spirit is saying to his church. Together, as a church family, we have seen thousands of lives transformed by the simple grace of Jesus every time we've gathered, hundreds have joined our church family, our children are finding and growing in faith through Emmanuel Kids and Emmanuel Youth, true redwood faith is increasing as people grow together in groups, and very simply the presence of God is among us!
